Looking to (literally) add some juice to your bar's soft drinks offering, Free Spirit has created a range of (ahem) 'adult' soft drinks, designed to make 'not-drinking drinking' not quite so dull. Recently launched to the on-trade, Free Spirit is an all-natural carbonated fruit drink that comes in five flavours, including Spiced Tomato and Lemon & Yuzu. They have high fruit content and no added sugar or artificial sweeteners. On their own, they deliver a non-synthetic finish, avoiding the teeth-coating that comes with many soft drinks - making a juice marathon totally doable.

Although they're designed to be drunk alone or in a mocktail, we felt the Spiced Tomato was topped off superbly with some vodka, to make a light, session-style take on a Bloody Mary, while a little warming whisky added to the Blood Orange variant was instant Christmas in a glass. Popcorn your Piña Colada

To satisfy the current trend for dessert and snack flavours in liquid form, Monin UK has added another flavour to its 140-strong portfolio, with the launch of its latest syrup, Popcorn. The first such product of its kind, according to Monin, it is designed to replicate the buttery, nutty flavour of the cinema classic in cocktails, milkshakes, coffees and other drinks.

As well as using it in coffee or adding it to a hard shake, recommended serves include a Popcorn Espresso Martini, Popcorn Mai Tai and Popcorn Colada. We're not sold on the Mai Tai, but the buttery notes really pimped out our Piña Colada.
